

LOCKDOWN PROCEDURE

Pegasus Schools, Eket prioritizes the safety of its pupils/students, staff, allied workers, and visitors above all else. As part of our commitment to ensuring a secure environment, the school has implemented a comprehensive lockdown policy and procedure. This procedure will be reviewed annually.

Types of Lockdown

Shelter-in-Place:

• Implemented for immediate safety within the school premises.

Internal Threat:

• In response to threats originating from within the school community.

External Threat:

• Enacted when threats arise from outside the school vicinity.

Full Lockdown:

• Implemented in cases of extreme danger, encompassing all aspects of the lockdown protocol.

Events that Require Lockdown

- Community Threat
- Hostage Situation
- Riots
- Police Activity Nearby
- National Disaster

School Lockdown Procedure with a Threat from Outside

- 1. The designated staff member (Announcer) will issue the announcement "LOCKDOWN with warning", ensuring outdoor lessons can hear the directive.
- 2. All exterior doors will be locked promptly.
- 3. Assistant Marshals will guide individuals on walkways and restrooms into designated classrooms.
- 4. Classroom windows will be secured and covered, while everyone is moved away from windows.
- 5. Class teachers will conduct a headcount, noting any missing individuals, and maintain a list.
- 6. Upon removal of the threat, an "all clear signal" will be announced by the designated staff.

School Lockdown Procedure with an Intruder

- 1. The Announcer will repeat the announcement "Lockdown with intruder".
- 2. All individuals must be directed to the nearest secure room without delay.
- 3. Outdoor lessons will move swiftly to designated safe spaces.
- 4. Classroom doors will be locked, but exterior doors will remain unlocked.
- 5. Everyone will be moved away from windows and doors, remaining seated on the floor.
- 6. Windows will be closed, and blinds lowered.
- 7. Class teachers will conduct a headcount, noting any missing individuals, and maintain a list.
- 8. Individuals must not respond to anyone at the door until an "all clear" signal is given.
- 9. Individuals should keep out of sight and move quietly if relocated from the classroom.
- 10. Upon elimination of the threat or intruder departure, the Announcer will issue an "all clear" signal.
